

Once your lab is approved for research resumption, AMRIS is available for your use with the following guidelines in place. We will be communicating updates and maintaining calendars to the best of our abilities to keep you apprised

We ask that all users kindly:

- 1. Wear your mask**
 - a. UF mandates wearing masks in all shared spaces. This applies to AMRIS and the MBI
 - b. We are not supplying masks to users
 - c. Masks may be removed only when in a closed room by yourself; it is best practice to keep them on while in AMRIS
 - d. Coughs and sneezes spread diseases. If you do remove your mask, cover your cough with your arm.
- 2. Wash your hands regularly**
 - a. A sink is available in LG 110-C (4.7/800/600 room) to wash your hands
 - b. If you choose to wear disposable gloves, they must go in the biohazard waste bin
- 3. Keep your distance**
 - a. It is recommended to keep 6 ft apart when possible
 - b. If your work requires someone in close proximity, then masks are essential
- 4. Minimize your time in AMRIS**
 - a. Calendars will be updated daily so that everyone is coordinated
 - b. Plan your time in AMRIS efficiently
 - c. Do not socialize in the shared spaces
 - d. Minimize conversations with others while in shared spaces
- 5. Remote Operation of Spectrometers**
 - a. Approved researchers are allowed into AMRIS and are asked to leave after sample has been placed in the probe/magnet and tuned (for non-automatic tuning probes)
 - b. We strongly encourage remote operation.
 - c. Staff may be able to load samples for you to minimize contacts
- 6. Occupancy limits and priority**
 - a. UF currently mandates strict occupancy limits. For stage 2, this is 250 sq. ft. per person are one person in small rooms, two people in the large instrument rooms.
 - b. Only the minimum number of researchers should come to AMRIS in person
 - c. We will post regular maintenance times, but, if incidental maintenance is needed, staff have priority and may ask you to leave an area to meet occupancy limits.
- 7. Cleaning**
 - a. Desks will be cleaned and sterilized daily
 - b. Keyboards will be wiped down and cleaned between users. You are welcome to bring your own keyboard and mouse if you prefer.
- 8. Meetings with Staff**
 - a. When you need to discuss anything with staff, please call us or contact us via zoom.

We strongly encourage you to discuss with AMRIS scientists the opportunities to remotely run and monitor samples, as this will help minimize the risks to everyone as well as improve your time management. We understand the inconveniences involved, and appreciate your understanding and consideration in following these rules.
